
VISION AND ETHOS

ABBROOK FARM





We are extremely privileged to have our own working Abbrook Farm, which provides students with a unique outdoor setting and a high-quality learning experience. Here, we offer land-based sciences and work accross the curriculum with departments, exploring sustainability, farm-to-table principles, environmental elements, and local habitats, giving students hands-on opportunities to connect classroom learning with the natural world

Farm Club is a popular extra-curricular activity and our Key Stage 4 students take on 'Farm Duty', supporting our Farm Technician to ensure the animals and plants are well looked after. There's even a volunteer staff rota to ensure the farm thrives during the school holidays too.









Teign Sixth Form College combines smaller, vibrant teaching classes with supportive pastoral care, all within a wider school community. At the heart of our provision is providing opportunities for students to excel academically and individually.

We offer a range of Level 3 courses, delivered by experienced subject specialists' with a proven track record of providing a high-quality education, alongside a wide and varied Enrichment programme supporting pupils to develop skills, independence and resilience.

Teign Sixth Form College is centred around knowing our students really well, identifying when intervention is required and ensuring every student is supported. Sixth Form students act as outstanding role models and hold many leadership positions in the wider school community.

The success of this approach is reflected in our results and many students choose to go onto university, including Russell Group and Oxbridge institutions, apprenticeships and employment.

Teign Sixth Form College has recently benefited from new facilities, including a Sixth Form only entrance, garden, study space, common room and café. In addition, every student is given a laptop to keep to ensure they have the equipment needed to study. Our Sixth Form continues to grow in numbers and each year we welcome students external to the school.
